TREVOR DAVIES was our July Monthly Triad speaker. Trevor is the chairman of the Monmouth Community Fund. Other Community Fund members are: Joel Newman, Ben Olson, Lucy Thompson, Cardie Carnes, Lisa Gavin and Anne Liby.



Trevor explained that the Monmouth Community Fund is in its beginning stage; when the committee receives \$70,000 in donations, the Twomey Foundation, the United Way, and the Galesburg Community Foundation will match that amount. Interest generated from the \$140,00 will be used to award grants to invest in the community. Every dollar stays in Monmouth. Trevor stated, "Our legacy is to perpetuate these funds in our communities

future".

The Advisory Board will review and decide on awarding the grants. The criteria requires that it benefits the Monmouth community. The funds are invested with the Galesburg Community Foundation who will partner with us.

Questions and answers followed Davies very informative and interesting presentation. More information will be forthcoming regarding the program.

MEDICARE D TIME JUST AROUND THE CORNER....

We have had numerous inquiries regarding the Yellow Medication Forms which we require to provide Medicare D Review in the Fall. We will start accepting the forms September 15th. However, we are updating the Medication Forms, and they will be ready to be picked up mid August. **Please wait to the September 15th date to submit them** either by mail or drop-off at our Strom Center in Monmouth or our Strom Henderson County Center in Oquawka. We will have a detailed letter of the back side of the form as to how the forms need to be completed. As with the past prior years, **ONLY** the Yellow Medication Forms will be accepted in scheduling appointments...we cannot accept pharmacy printouts, written or typed forms, etc. Medication Forms are turned in, numbered by staff person Lisa Ray, and appointments are scheduled accordingly. 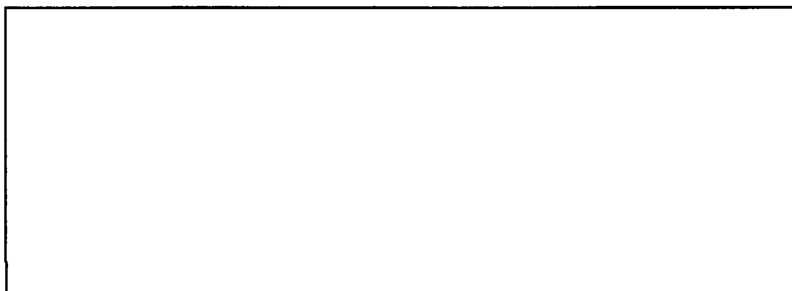
